



RESOLUTION 11-1  
REGARDING PARTICIPATION WITH THE PROFESSIONAL PETROLEUM  
DATA MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATION (PPDM)

WHEREAS, The Ground Water Protection Council (GWPC) is a national association of state ground water and underground injection control agencies whose mission is to promote the protection and conservation of ground water resources for all beneficial uses, and

WHEREAS, The Professional Petroleum Data Management (PPDM) Association is a global, not-for-profit standards organization that works collaboratively with industry to create and publish data management standards for the resource industry, and


WHEREAS, the PPDM Association is the custodian of the oil and gas related well numbering standard formerly known as the API D12A number, and

WHEREAS, both organizations recognize the importance of accurately and consistently identifying every wellbore in a well's configuration;

THEREFORE NOW BE IT RESOLVED that the GWPC be an active participant in the PPDM Association Well Identification project, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the GWPC work with the PPDM Association's Well Identification Workgroup in its effort to develop methods for consistently identifying all wellbores in the US.
