








Traditional Intersection

- Source Water Protection
 - Nutrients
 - Sediment
 - HABs
- Water Quantity
- Use, Reuse, Disposal







"New" Legal Intersections

- Injection well → navigable water
- Impoundment/pond → ground water or surface water
- Pipeline
 surface water or ground water
- Sewer Overflows → ground water to navigable water

Key Questions

- Is the activity already regulated?
- Is the activity being conducted in accordance with other state and federal regulations?
- Is the discharge a planned, authorized activity or is it an illicit activity?
- · What is the role of permitting vs enforcement discretion





Late Breaking News

- Supreme Court has agreed to take up the cases that caused the split in the circuit courts
