## JASON MEADOWS

Hydrologist, EPA Region 4, Office of Water, UIC Program

Jason Meadows is a Hydrologist with U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region 4 Office in Atlanta, Georgia, in the Underground Injection Control (UIC) Program. Jason is also the Chair of EPA's National Technical Workgroup, which is a forum for federal and state UIC program experts to meet regularly and work through technical issues related to underground injection. His UIC programmatic work includes coordination of delegated state programs in EPA Region 4 as well as regulation of EPA UIC Class I, II, III and V injection wells under EPA's direct implementation of the UIC Program in Georgia, Florida, and Kentucky. In early 2023, Jason began serving as the EPA Co-Chair of GWPC's Aquifer Storage and Recovery - Managed Aquifer Recharge (ASR-MAR) Workgroup.

Prior to joining EPA Region 4, Jason was a geologist in Brown and Caldwell's Atlanta area office, and he was a GIS technician in Greenville, South Carolina.

Jason holds a B.S. in Geology from Clemson University. He studied Fluvial Geomorphology at the University of Georgia and received his M.S. in Hydrogeology from Clemson University.
